Metal Detectors – If you don't need it for work, leave it in your car.

- Remove EVERYTHING from your pockets
- Open all compartments of Purse
- Use clear plastic bags
- Wait to be called on to enter the metal detector

Property Passes

ANY SBD item needs a property pass when exiting the building.

ACTIVE AGGRESSOR RESPONSE:

There are three options:

RUN

- > The BEST option if safe to do so.
- **EVACUATE** the premises.

• HIDE

- If RUN is not possible, find a place to HIDE.
- > Your hiding place SHOULD NOT trap you.



• FIGHT

- AS a last resort incapacitate the active aggressor
 by using aggressive force and weapons of
 opportunity.
 What YOU should do when Police arrive.
 - Immediately comply with Police orders.
 - Immediately raise hands and spread fingers



- Emergency Alerts for Fire: NO AUDIBLE ALARM (Primary Fire Alarm will Sound)
- Emergency Alerts for Tornado/Severe Weather:
- Emergency Alerts for Active Aggressor: NO AUDIBLE ALARM
- Emergency Alerts for Evacuation :
